What is the **General Knowledge Test**?

The General Knowledge Test is given to all instructional candidates to evaluate their skills and knowledge before becoming professional educators.

I. The General Knowledge Test consists of four subtests:

- Essay Subtest
 - 1 Essay
 - 50 minutes
- English Language Skills (ELS) Subtest
 - ELS Subtest: approximately 40 multiple-choice questions
 - 40 minutes
- Reading Subtest
 - Reading Subtest: approximately 40 multiple-choice questions
 - 55 minutes
- Mathematics Subtest
 - Mathematics Subtest: approximately 45 multiple-choice questions
 - 1 hour and 40 minutes

II. Scoring

- a. Essay Subtest: At least 8 out of 12 points
ELS, Reading, and Mathematics Subtests: a scaled score of at least 200 per subtest
Examinees must pass all 4 subtests to pass the GK
